## **Consignment Agreement**

The Literary is proud to support local authors! As a small store, however, it is impossible for us to accept every request for a consignment position. We prefer to give priority to authors whose books appeal to local interests, although we will happily consider all books submitted. Selections will be made based on our experience with the bookstore's inventory, customer base, and sales history. We reserve the right to refuse to accept books for sale for any reason.

If you're interested in selling your book through The Literary, please read over the following guidelines before contacting us.

Due to the economics of carrying and selling books by independent, self-published authors, it is our policy to take such books on consignment. For local authors who are publishing through an established publisher, we will be happy to purchase books through those channels.

Strong preference is given to books that have the following:

- 1) Printed and bound spine displaying the title and author name (no spiral binding).
- 2) Paperback, hardcover, board, or equivalent cover displaying the title and author name.
- 3) 13-digit International Standard Book Number (ISBN) and bar code.
- 4) Suggested retail price printed on the back cover, or jacket flap.

At this time, we do not charge a stocking fee for titles left on consignment. We reserve the right to change this at any point in the future.

### **Consignment Terms**

Authors may sell their books at The Literary for a one-time \$25 fee. All proceeds from sales of the title consigned will be paid directly to the author by check at the end of the term. All consignment contracts are for 30-day periods. Authors must pick up their remaining books at the end of 30 days. If books are not picked up by the author, The Literary reserves the right to dispose of the books as it sees fit.

All communications will take place via email at [hello@literarybookbar.com](mailto:hello@literarybookbar.com). The Literary will reach out to the author to request additional stock if needed. Sales results will be reported at the end of the 30-day consignment term.

The Literary reserves the right to discontinue consignments for any reason at any time. If The Literary discontinues the consignment before the end of the 30-day term, the authors will be credited the prorated remainder of the \$25 fee for the remaining days.

The author reserves the right to discontinue their consignment at any time for any reason. Discontinuing the consignment prior to the end of the 30 day term will result in the author's forfeiting the \$25 consignment fee.
