Consignment Agreement

The Literary is proud to support local authors!

As a small store, however, we must have some guidelines in navigating the economics of carrying and selling books by independent, self-published authors. It is our policy to take such books on consignment. We prefer to give priority to authors who are local, and/or whose books appeal to local interests, although we will review all books submitted. Selections will be made based on our experience with the bookstore's inventory, customer base, and sales history. The Literary reserves the right to refuse consignment for any reason.

Books must also meet the following requirements:

- Printed and bound spine, preferably displaying the title and the author name (no spiral binding)
- Paperback, hardcover, board, or equivalent cover displaying the title and author name.
- 13-digit International Standard Book Number (ISBN) and bar code.

If you are interested in consigning with The Literary after being reviewed, and if your book meets these requirements, please read the following **Consignment Terms**:

- Authors may sell their books at The Literary for a \$25 fee per consignment term. Consignment terms are one month periods, from the 1st to the 1st of each month. Consignment fees can be paid via cash, check, or card, and must be paid prior to books being placed on the shelf.
- Authors will receive 100% of sales. Sales are paid directly to the author via check at the end of the consignment term.
- 5 copies maximum.

All communications will take place via email at specialorders@literarybookbar.com. The Literary will reach out to the author to request additional stock if needed. Sales results will be reported at the end of the consignment term. At that time, authors may decide to extend or conclude their consignment with us. Authors will also be given the option to pick up their pay-out amount, or have it mailed to them. Additionally, authors may pay the next term's consignment fee by applying the amount from their sales.

If the author decides to conclude their consignment with us, they will have 30 days to pick up any remaining unsold copies of their book. If their books have not been picked

up at the end of that 30 day period, the copies will be donated or otherwise disposed of per The Literary's discretion. If an author chooses to ship their copies to the store rather than drop them off, and would like any remaining copies shipped back at the end of their term, they are responsible for paying the shipping costs. This can be done by any payment method, or by having the cost deducted from their pay-out amount.

The Literary reserves the right to discontinue consignments for any reason at any time. If The Literary discontinues the consignment before the end of the term, the authors will be credited the prorated remainder of the \$25 fee for the remaining days.

The author reserves the right to discontinue their consignment at any time for any reason. Discontinuing the consignment prior to the end of the term will result in the author's forfeiting the \$25 consignment fee.
